Acropolis to the Monistiraki and Plaka neighborhoods with time
for gelato! Return to the hotel for dinner.

Day 8 Thursday, April 6, 2023 Saronic Islands | Athens Travel to the Piraeus and the Trocadero Terminal to board your cruise ship to the islands of the Saronic Gulf. Visit Aegina, Poros and Hydra with lunch onboard the ship. Evening return to Athens. Pack your belongings for the early return flight. B/L/D

PAYMENT SCHEDULE:

CANCELLATION POLICY:

- Until 90 days prior to departure = Full refund
